

Your quick guide to handling first and emergencies on campus!

What To DO

For minor injuries during regular working hours;

Carry out first aid as required.

Notify Security Services at **403.329.2345** (2345 from any in house phone).

If the injured person can walk, accompany them to the University Health Centre.

In case of serious injury immediately call 911. If not an emergency contact Security Services and follow their instructions until a first aid responder arrives.

Who Responds

Security Representatives are trained as first responders to all medical emergencies on campus. Staff in other departments may also be trained to provide basic first aid.

How to Call for Help

Emergency phones are strategically placed throughout campus to provide a "one touch" method of requesting immediate assistance.

Campus security, can also be reached by dialing 2345 from any University phone or by calling 403.329.2345 from any cell phone.

Security Representatives are available every day, 24 hours a day.

Where to Find First Ald Kits/AED

Automatic external defibrillators (AEDs) are located in each building. First aid kits are located in each building in most administrative areas.

Take time to familiarize yourself with the areas of campus you use and learn where kits and defibrillators are located.

Please note, when the AED housing is accessed it will emit a very high alarm.
