**What:** ASPIRE offers year-round, on-campus activities to a wide age range of children

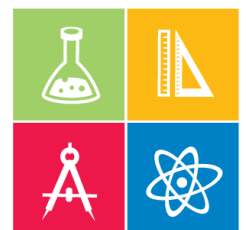
