- One page proposal expressing your interest in innovation or entrepreneurship in agribusiness

This award of \$1,500 is payable upon confirmation of full-time enrolment at the University of Lethbridge in the current semester immediately following the granting of the award. Selection will be by a committee, which will include a faculty member teaching in Agricultural Studies and Student Awards committee members.

It is your responsibility to ensure that all requested information is attached. **Incomplete or late applications will not be considered.** The Scholarships and Student Finance Office is not responsible for any applications lost in the delivery system.
