Film 1 - Terre Battue (40 Love)

(Belgium, Stéphane Demoustier, 2014) Jerome loses his job and his wife leaves him for another man, and he is left to manage his 11-year-old son's fledgling tennis career.

Film 2 - I Wish

(Japan, Hirokazu Koreeda, 2011)

Twelve-year-old Koichi, who has been separated from his brother Ryunosuke due to his parents' divorce, hears a rumor that the new bullet trains will precipitate a wishgranting miracle when they pass each other at top speed. Rated PG (In Japanese w/ English subtitles)

Film 3 - Aquí y Allá (Here and There)

(Mexico, Antonio Méndez Esparza, 2012)

Pedro, a Mexican immigrant who returns home to a small mountain village in Guerrero, Mexico after years of working in the US, and struggles to rebuild his family and follow his dream of starting a band: the Copa Kings. Rated NR (In Spanish w/ English subtitles)

(Venezuela, Jorge Thielen Armand, 2016)

A vivid and intimate account of the Venezuelan crisis told through the real-life struggle of a young father trying to save his family from the demolition of their home.
