# **Position description:**

In addition to working as a tutor at the Math and Stats Help Sessions, the supervisor will work with the Department of Mathematics and Computer Science and the Student Success Centre to schedule, advertise, and ensure the smooth day-to-day operation of the Math and Stats Help Sessions. This will include scheduling tutors' shifts to best accommodate attendance fluctuations throughout the semester, personally advertising the Help Sessions in mathematics and statistics classes at the beginning of each semester, providing input on hiring decisions at the Help Sessions, and collecting attendance statistics throughout the semester to present in a report at the end of each semester. The weekly time commitment for the position will vary but will likely average to three to four hours per week, with more hours being worked at the beginning and end of each semester and less in the middle. Compensation will be \$1050.00 per semester.

## **Necessary qualifications for applicants:**

- Applicants must be registered U of L undergraduate or graduate students in the Fall 2018 semester. Preference will be given to applicants who will be available to continue in the position past the Fall 2018 semester.
- In addition to three to four hours of work per week as the supervisor, applicants must be available to work as a Help Sessions tutor at least two evenings per week.
