

What? NVivo (<u>QSR International.com</u>) is a popular qualitative data analysis software.

- **Who?** This course is suitable for NVivo 10 and NVivo 11 users (Starter, Pro or Plus) with little or no experience.
- **What?** This full-day hands-on workshop will walk you through the basics of NVivo and provide you with information and practice to get you started in your own project.
