Interventions to Change Practice in Long-Term Care Facilities

What Works, For Whom, in What Circumstance, And Why?

Dr. Sienna Caspar has worked in long-term care facilities in both Canada and the United States for over 20 years as both a certified therapeutic recreation specialist and a consultant. She is the author of the MARRCC (Measurable Assessment in Recreation for Resident-Centred Care). She has studied long-term care during both her MA at SFU and her PhD at UBC. More recently, as a postdoctoral fellow in a cross appointment at the Toronto Rehabilitation Institute/University Health Network and the University of Victoria, she conducted an intervention study aimed at improving leadership and collaborative decision making in long-term care settings. Currently, she is an assistant professor at the University of Lethbridge in the Faculty of Health Sciences - Therapeutic Recreation program.
