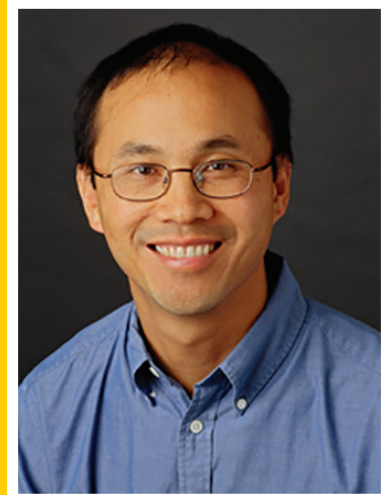

Solving the Problem of Homelessness

A physician at St. Michael's Hospital and at Seaton House, Canada's largest men's shelter, Dr. Stephen Hwang is among the world's most influential researchers in the area of homelessness, housing and health. He is working to ensure homeless and vulnerably-housed people can access and benefit from health and mental health care services, and ultimately, get the help they need to exit homelessness. In his talk, he will outline the social and health implications of homelessness, discuss the effectiveness of Housing First in ending chronic homelessness, and explain inadequacies in current approaches to helping the homeless.
