

## **Study Participants Needed!**

You are invited to participate in a research study about the <u>relationship between</u> employees with musculoskeletal injuries and their supervisors.

## Who can participate in the study?

Anyone who:

- 1. is currently employed,
- 2. has experienced a <u>musculoskeletal injury</u> (e.g. back/neck pain, broken bones, etc.) sometime in the **past two years**,
- 3. had to take at least one day off work because of the injury, and
- 4. has returned to work since the injury.

## What does the study involve?

The study involves answering an online questionnaire and will take about 15 minutes of your time. We will also ask your permission to invite your supervisor to answer questions about your relationship. You will complete the survey first, and then you will be asked for your <u>supervisor's contact information</u>. If your supervisor agrees to participate, he or she will be provided a link to the supervisor survey. The survey will be anonymous, your supervisor will not see your answers and you will not see your supervisor's answers. The data will be analyzed and published without any identifying information about the participants.
