My approach to the study of gender and sexuality is explicitly feminist in its exploration of power, and foregrounds a critical race

Istmo Zapotec, feminine males are known as muxes. In this talk, I will present an overview of my 15 years of research at both of these fieldsites and discuss my work in relation to current controversies pertaining to transgender issues in Canada.
