General Requirements

Students must complete at least four courses (12.0 credit hours), including at least one course (3.0 credit hours) at the 3000/4000 level.

Students may not double count courses required for the minor in fulfilling requirements for their major or second minor. The four courses comprising the minor must be distinct from any such major or second minor requirements.

For students who complete the required courses, the minor will be acknowledged on the official transcript.

Minors are available in the Bachelor of Management degree, Post-Diploma Bachelor of Management degree, Professional Diploma in Accounting, Management Certificate and second degrees in Management.

Some minors are available in the combined degrees programs. Please refer to Part 13 of the University of Lethbridge Calendar for full details.

Note: Students cannot take a minor in the same subject as their major.

Why Complete a Population Health Minor?

This minor covers the determinants and dynamics of health at a macro level, and is ideal for Management students who plan to work in the health care field. Students will be introduced to topics such as ecology of health and disease, ethics and public health, health and society, public health, and men's and women's health.

Minimum Grade Requirement

A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses taken towards the Population Health Minor.
