**Residence Requirement** Students must complete a minimum of five courses towards a Management Certificate at the University of Lethbridge.

**Time Limit** All certificate requirements must be completed within five years after acceptance into the Dhillon School of Business.

**Minimum Grade Requirement** A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses taken towards a Certificate program.
