

How to Format a Music Program - Cheat Sheet

To indent movements within the table press and hold Ctrl then press the Tab key.

Performer Name, instrument

Titles alone are *italicized*

Introduction and Rondo Capriccioso

Camille Saint Saëns
(1835-1921)

Performer Name, instrument

Songs from a larger work/opera in "quotes" while the title of the work is *italicized*.

"Czardas" from *Die Fledermaus*

Johann Strauss Jr.
(1825-1899)

Performer Name, instrument

- Instrument names are always lowercased, unless it is French horn or English horn.
- When performing a work with multiple movements all movements must be identified in some way, either by number, by tempo marking (standard), by descriptive title, or by all of these.
- Performer names can either be separated by a Return or a Semi-colon (;)
 - o Example:
Nick Sullivan, bass trombone; Bente Hansen, piano (or)
Nick Sullivan, bass trombone
Bente Hansen, piano
