Overview: This committee is tasked with oversight of all Convocation Ceremonies, approving the

schedule of events, order of proceedings, citations for honorary degree recipients and

award winners, and

This year, the committee oversaw the Fall 2012 and the Spring 2013 Ceremonies in which we had over 1700 graduates over the 5 ceremonies, a new Chair of the Board of

Governors, and the unveiling of the official U of L Coat of Arms.

Meetings: The GFC Convocation Committee met 2 times this year:

October 2, 2012

There was discussion of the events surrounding the 45th Anniversary Homecoming Celebrations which took place the same weekend as Convocation.

May 7, 2013

There was discussion on the impact construction would have on the ceremonies, as all aspects of convocation needed to be moved up the hill. The new video created by Advancement was shown to the committee, and an update was given on the cancellation of the flag project due to budgetary

restrictions.

Upcoming: In 2013/14, the GFC Convocation Committee will continue to meet regularly prior to

each Convocation Ceremony with regards to the planning and operating of the ceremonies. As it was seen with the cancellation of the flag project, we could see further restrictions placed on convocation due to budgetary concerns over the next year. It is also the intention to look at ways to increase the student experience at

Convocation.
