3. REPORTS

3.1 Chancellor

S. McClellan reported on the recent visit by Jim Prentice to campus before the change in Government. Presentation they viewed by David Hill was fantastic regarding ways to make Southern Alberta a global player in food production. Passed to Mike to talk more about the Destination Project.

3.2 President & Vice-Chancellor

M. Mahon reported some special people that the University has lost recently, Hironaka, Coutts, McNally, Cox and Penny, held a moment of silence in honour. Started the new academic year with New Student Orientation, which this year featured Commencement Ceremony. Very well received and will be included each year going forward. Had 1500 students attend, which is very much higher than previous years. Perhaps in future years we can look at including Senate in this event.

Dan Weeks has left to become President at UNBC, Lesley Brown is Interim VP (Research), and Matt Letts is Associate VP (Research).

Patterson Centre is now temporary FNMI gathering space.

Two new programs added over summer.

Mike now part of the Alberta Innovation Council – the only Post Secondary rep. Recent announcements were the Potato Growers \$1m gift, and Cor van Raay \$5m split between us and the College.

Fiat Lux Address was this past Thursday, announced the 50 by 50 plan, UofL turns 50 in 2017, and we plan to have 50 Research Chairs by then.
