REPORTS

10.1 Chancellor

Chancellor Shirley McClellan reported on her activities as Chancellor since her installation. Shirley advised the Senate that her Installation and Convocation was an amazing experience. She is trying to be involved as much as possible, and attends meetings via phone when she is unable to attend in person.

10.2 President & Vice-Chancellor

Mike Mahon started off by giving a few highlights of what has been happening at the University in the last few months:

- The Students Union attended the relay for life the night prior to the meeting, and have yet to sleep;
- Mike attended the "Jail and Bail' event to raise money to build 100 classrooms in Afghanistan;
- The IGEM team won an Alberta-based competition for high end biochemistry, and are off to Indianapolis for a Regional Competition.
- Mike attended a Conference for new University Presidents at Harvard in the Summer. There were 2 Canadian Presidents and 48 American Presidents;
- Mike delivered the Fiat Lux address at the end of September. The address can be viewed on the Office of the President website at www.uleth.ca/president.
- The Fall, 2011 enrollment is at 8,457 students;
- The Province has given the University \$5.6 million for funding for the Physical Education Complex and the development of a Sport Medicine Clinic;
- New base funding has been received for audio/visio arts;
- Province funding for planning of a new science building;

- 2nd Annual Alberta Graduate Conference: Will be held shortly to bridge the gap between Academia and Industry.
