## Program Information

For the benefit of international students whose first language is not English, the University offers English for Academic Purposes Program. Students in the EAP enjoy the advantage of working with different EAP instructors, experiencing a variety of teaching styles and approaches. Our qualified and TESL- Certified teachers are dedicated to providing a high standard of instruction, using contemporary teaching methods, up-to-date resources, and technological applications to enhance learning.

Program entry is available in January, May and September each year. Note that new students must complete a placement assessment during orientation to determine their level in the EAP program.

Each level of EAP consists of two courses: Reading/Writing and Communication. Each course is 10 hours/week in the Fall, Spring and Summer for 12 weeks.

**Note:** Successful completion of the Advanced EAP level satisfies the University's English Language Proficiency Requirement for applicants to undergraduate academic programs.
