PURPOSE OF THE ALUMNI ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS

The Alumni Achievement Awards recognize University of Lethbridge alumni excellence, leadership and innovation in their contributions to the social, cultural and economic well-being of our communities.

These annual awards:

- · Celebrate and honour alumni who have consistently demonstrated outstanding achievement
- Raise the University's profile and highlight our alumni's accomplishments
- Creates connections between the alumni community, the University community and the community at large
- · Strengthen alumni pride and affinity to the University and the ULAA

NOMINEE ELIGIBILITY

- Recipients of an award will be formally recognized at an awards ceremony October 12, 2018, and are expected to attend the event to receive the award in person.
- The Distinguished Alumnus/a of the Year and Young Alumnus/a of the Year must be available to attend Fall convocation on October 13, 2018, in addition to the October 12 awards ceremony.
- Awards cannot be given to current members of the University's Board of Governors or the ULAA Council.
- Awards will not normally be granted to current staff members, unless they have demonstrated commitment and excellence beyond the scope of their duties.
- Recipients must hold a degree, certificate and/or diploma from the University of Lethbridge.
- Posthumous nominations will not be considered.

NOMINATION PROCESS

- Nominations will be accepted on a rolling basis with a cut-off deadline to be established and published annually.
- All nominations must be completed correctly and legibly to be accepted for consideration.
 The nomination committee will not solicit additional materials in the case of an incomplete nomination.
- Nominations shall include all requirements as stated and no more; any additional information will be discounted as per the pre-determined cut-off.
- Nominations will stand for consideration the year in which they are submitted, and, if a nominee is not selected, the nomination will stand for the following two years if approved to do so by the selection committee and providing the nominator gives an annual update.
- Nominators of unsuccessful nominations will be notified by email or letter and will indicate whether the nomination will stand for a second/ third year or if the nomination has expired. If the nomination has expired, the nominator can submit again through the regular nomination process.
- Nominations will be treated with confidentiality.
 Nomination forms and other materials will not be returned and will be destroyed following the expiration of the nomination.
- The ULAA reserves the right to determine the number of Alumni Achievement Award recipients in any year.



CRITERIA

Distinguished Alumnus/a of the Year Criteria

This premier award recognizes a University of Lethbridge alumnus/a, or honorary alumnus/a, whose accomplishments in the public, private or not-for-profit sector have earned national and/or international prominence as a result of their exceptional professional achievements and/or service to society.

Outstanding/significant will be characterized by qualities including but not limited to:

- · Prominence and acclaim in an alumnus/a's chosen field
- · Consistent and comprehensive record of excellence and achievement beyond the norm
- Persistent effort and courage in the face of adversity
- · Innovative and effective approaches to challenging problems
- · Ongoing and positive effect on their field and/or other people

Young Alumnus/a of the Year

This award recognizes a young alumnus/a (aged 35 or under) whose accomplishments are of such excellence that they provide inspiration and leadership to University of Lethbridge students and fellow young alumni. The recipient has shown significant leadership either in their professional career and/or community, public or humanitarian service.

Alumni Honour Society

This award recognizes the outstanding contributions made over the years by University of Lethbridge alumni in their local communities and beyond.
