WHAT IS SEXUAL VIOLENCE?

At the University of Lethbridge, sexual violence is any sexual act or act targeting a person's sexuality, gender identity or gender expression – whether the act is physical or psychological in nature – that is committed, threatened, or attempted against a person without the person's consent, and includes sexual assault, sexual harassment, stalking, indecent exposure, voyeurism, and sexual exploitation.

SEXUAL VIOLENCE

If the sexual assault just happened:

- 1. Call 911 and Campus Security 403-410-1713
- 2. Refer to Sheldon Chumir room to access medical care, CSART team.
- 3. Discourage the person from washing their clothing, showering or bathing.
- 4. Don't touch the individual or disturb anything from the scene of the incident.
- 5. Listen, believe, support. Do not ask questions about drinking, clothing etc. as they are blaming.
- 6. Provide 24Hr crisis line number: 780-423-4121
