Additional Admission Requirement for Native Education Majors

For admission consideration, Native Education Majors must present with the following:

- Completion of at least *three* of the seven courses required in a <u>main school subject</u> minor. Not all Education minors are applicable; only those that are considered main teachable subjects.
- Main teachable areas can be chosen from any of the 11 subjects available to Education majors.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 required in the non-Education courses comprising the minor (for admission and graduation).

Note: Education minor requirements are typically comprised of five non-Education courses. For those pursuing a Native Education major, a minimum of seven courses in an applicable minor is required. These courses must include those listed in the standard requirements for Education minors plus an additional two courses of the student's choice in the area of the minor.
