Additional Admission Requirement for Indigenous Education Majors

For admission consideration, Indigenous Education Majors must present the following:

- Completion of at least three of the seven courses required in a <u>main school subject</u> minor.
 - Main school subject minors include:
 - Art Education
 - CTS: Business Focus or New Media Focus
 - Drama Education
 - English Language Arts Education
 - Mathematics Education
 - Modern Languages Education
 - Music Education
 - Physical Education
 - Science Education
 - Social Studies Education
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 required in the non-Education courses comprising the minor (for admission and graduation).

Note: Education minor requirements are typically comprised of five non – Education courses. However, for those pursuing an Indigenous Education major, a minimum of seven courses in an applicable minor is required. These courses must include those listed in the standard requirements for Education minors, plus an additional two courses of the student's choice in the area of the minor.
