

#### \$50 – application fee \$100 – deposit

- You withdraw your application before you receive an offer to live on campus
- We are unable to offer you a room







# **Dining Plan Options**

#### **Commuter Plan**

The Commuter Plan option is designed for students who do not plan to remain on campus most weekends and holidays. The Commuter Plan is suited to those students with more modest appetites. Total Cost: \$3,665

#### **Standard Plan**

The Standard Plan is best suited for students who plan to spend more time on campus including some weekends and holidays. The Standard Plan is also recommended for those students with larger appetites.

#### Total Cost: \$4,245

The Commuter and Standard Dining Plans have two key components: Base Dollars and Flex Dollars.

# **Dining Plan Options**

Base Dollars allow you to purchase food from all Chartwells operated dining outlets on campus. Base Dollar purchases are tax free.. Base Dollars are non-refundable and must be used by the end of the Spring Term. Flex Dollars allow you to purchase food from any Chartwells operated dining outlet on campus, buy food via the After Hours residence delivery program, and purchase at most Snack & Beverage vending machines on campus. All purchases are taxable (GST). Flex Dollars are no risk. Any Flex Dollars remaining at the end of the Spring Term will be transferred in full to your Bridgebucks account on May 1.
