



## WITHDRAWAL WITH CAUSE STUDENT ACKNOWLEDGMENT

The designation 'WC' is recorded only in case of serious illness or other extenuating circumstances beyond your control, making continuation in a course impossible, where an 'Incomplete' designation is not in order. Students will not receive a Withdrawal With Cause in two consecutive terms for the same circumstance. To be considered for a WC, students must provide supporting documentation from a counsellor or medical professional. If approved, the WC will apply to all registered courses in a term.

### IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Counselling Services offers confidential appointments to assess personal and academic situations, and the Health Centre provides nurse and physician care, should you require these services.
  - Documentation required in support of your Withdrawal With Cause may come from either on-campus or off-campus offices.
  - To ensure that you are well enough to successfully return to school, prior to registering in courses, the Faculty of Health Sciences will request that you provide documentation from a counsellor or medical professional supporting your ability to return to your studies.
  - Submission of supporting documentation does not guarantee that special consideration or continuation will be granted.
