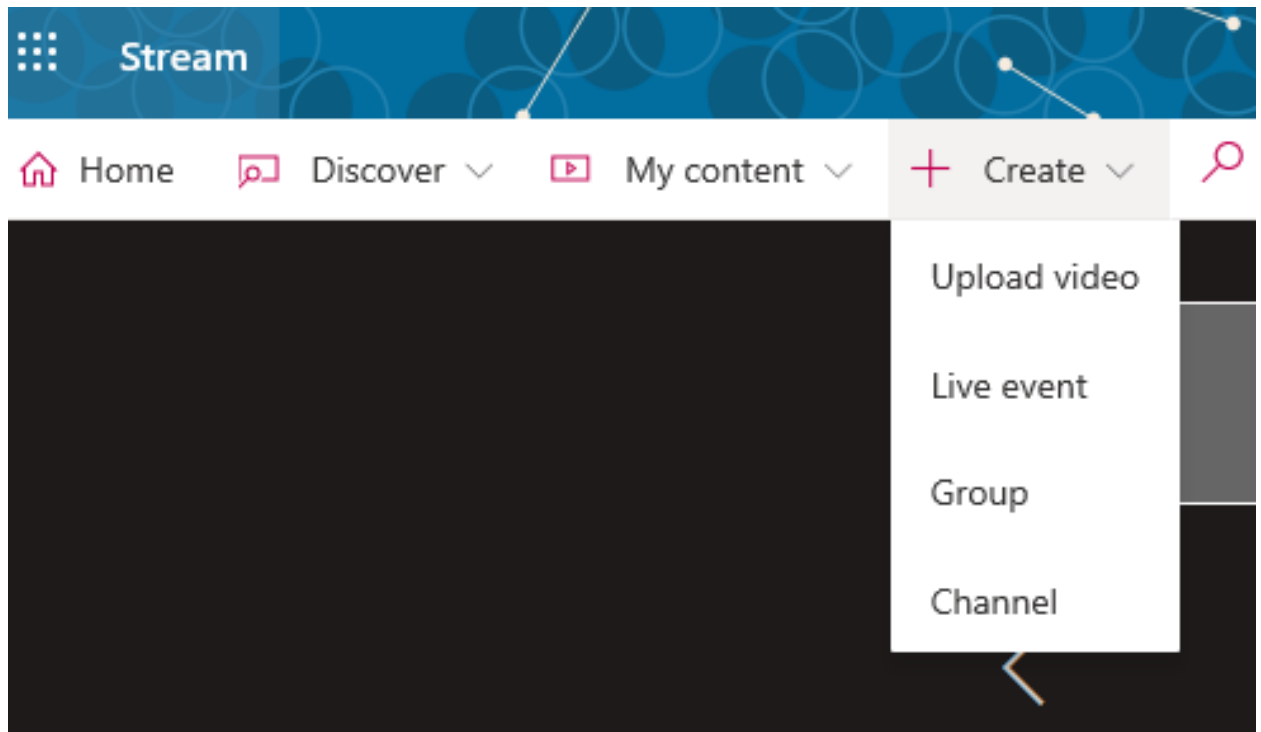


1. You create a group for a class/section.



2. Turn off that all group members can contribute (see below) this limits who can upload videos,
3. Make it public (anyone with a credential can see it so this would include students) and
4. Click create

Create a Microsoft Stream group connected to an Office 365 group as an easy way to organize who has permission to see and edit your videos and channels.

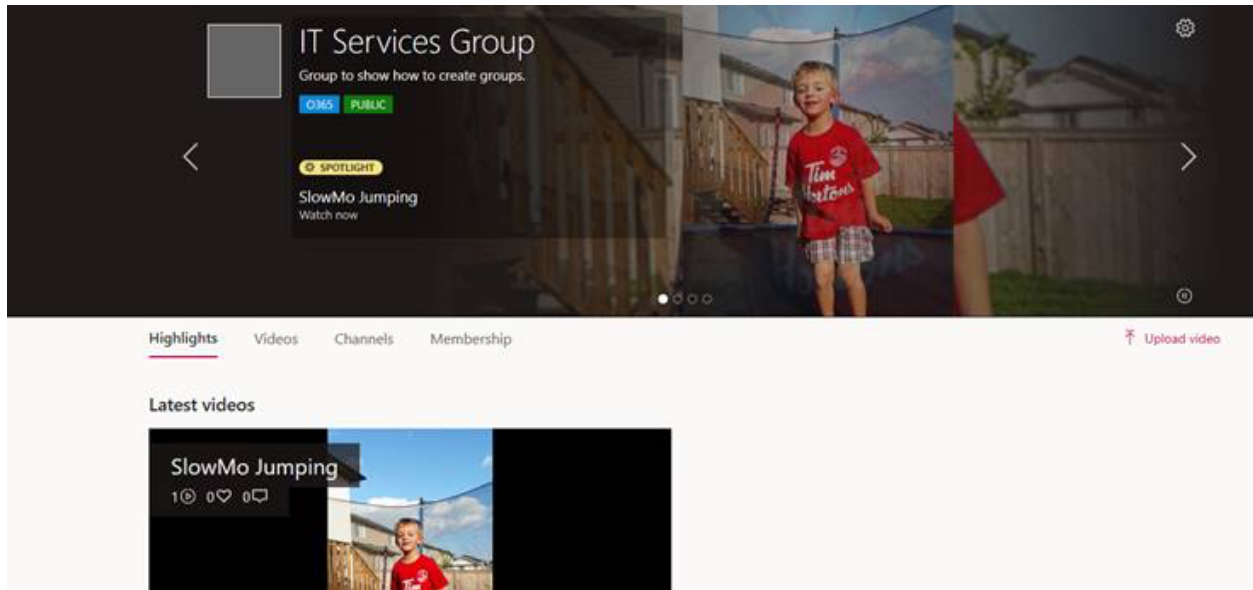

You can then upload videos and share [links directly to videos](#) or share a [link](#) to the group or to a [channel](#) within a group which you can use to further group content (you can also follow channels which will notify you about new content). They can also control what is featured as they get a landing page for their videos if they want to customize it but it is not required.



If wanted, you can make the content private. A private group can be made as well, but then members need to be added.
