Credit/Non-Credit (CR/NC) Policy for Spring 2020 Faculty of Education Undergraduate Admission Requirements April 22, 2020

In light of the COVID-19 pandemic, the **CR/NC** option was made available to students for the Spring 2020 term. Students considering this option, who are planning to apply to the Faculty of Education for **Fall 2021**, are advised to review the following guidelines to determine *how the CR/NC option may affect admission eligibility*.

To be considered for admission to the Faculty of Education, the following *minimum* requirements must be met by the March 1 document deadline:

- A. Minimum admission GPA of 2.50 (on the U of L 4.00 scale), calculated on all University of Lethbridge, transferable and university-level courses taken within the terms containing the last 14 courses (42.0 credit hours). <u>All courses must be graded</u>.
 - CR, NC and Pass (P) courses will not count towards the minimum 14 'graded' courses required (42 credit hours)
 - Fail (F) grades will count towards the admission GPA if the course falls within the terms containing the last 14 graded courses or is part of the major. A Fail will also count towards the U of L GPA (unless repeated)
- B. At least five courses (15.0 credit hours) in a major, or
- C. At least eight courses (24.0 credit hours) in a 16-course general major, including at least four courses (12.0 credit hours) in the main teaching subject area
 - All Graded and CR courses (Spring 2020 only) will count towards the minimum number of courses required in the major
 - NC courses will not count towards the minimum number of courses required in the major
 - Fail courses will count towards the major (unless repeated)
- D. A minimum major GPA of 2.50 calculated on all 'graded' courses comprising the major
 - All graded courses comprising the major will factor into the major GPA. Minimum number of 'graded' courses in the major is not specified
- E. **Education 2500** Orientation to Teaching (or equivalent) to be completed *prior to* the fall program intake. Favourable recommendation (Pass/Recommend) from the instructor is required for admission eligibility.
 - U of L offering of EDUC 2500 is a Pass/Fail course
 - Pass courses will not count towards the minimum number of courses required for admission
- F. Additional admission requirements for the Indigenous Education Major:

Completion of three of the seven courses required in the school subject minor. A minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 is required on all 'graded' courses comprising the minor.

- CR courses (Spring 2020 only) will count towards the minimum of three courses required in the minor
- Minimum number of 'graded' courses in the mandatory minor is not specified



Grading

Pass/Fail

- Courses defined as Pass/Fail will result in the awarding of 'P' or the grade 'F' (e.g. EDUC 2500)
- Pass (ungraded) course credit satisfactory completion of the course; excluded from the GPA calculation
- Fail (graded) unsatisfactory completion of the course; included in the GPA calculation

Credit/Non-Credit (available option extended to students in Spring 2020)

- CR will count towards degree/program requirements; no impact on GPA
- NCR will not count towards degree or program requirements; no impact on GPA

Additional Notes

- Only CR courses from Spring 2020 will be allowed to count towards meeting the minimum number of courses required in the *major* or the *mandatory minor for the Indigenous Education major*
- If students choose the CR/NC option for Spring 2020 courses, but the decision results in being short the minimum number of 'graded' courses required for <u>early admission</u> consideration, please note that applying to the Faculty of Education by February 1 the following year will still allow for completion of program requirements within the standard academic timeframe (in most cases)
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 2.50 in the major (and non-Education courses comprising the minor) must be
 maintained to graduate from the Faculty of Education
- Only courses completed by the admission *document deadline* will be considered for admission. *Exceptions are made* for the completion of Education 2500 when applicants are completing the course over the spring or summer preceding the fall admission intake
- Application Deadline: February 1
- Document Deadline: March 1
