

Peter & the Wolf Pieces for Storyboard (cut these out)



*NOTE: the words in () tell you which music clip to play (see website on your storyboard for the music clips).

As he entered the meadow, he saw a little bird sitting in a tree not too far away, chirping merrily to herself. (BIRD) Soon a duck came waddling by on his way to the stream. (DUCK) When the little bird saw the duck, she flew down and began arguing with him. "How can you be a bird if you can not fly?" the bird asked. The duck replied angrily "How can you be a bird if you can not swim?" and he dove into the water.

From a distance, Peter noticed a big cat creeping through the grass toward the two arguing birds. The cat was stalking the little bird and thinking, "They are so busy arguing, that they won't even notice me, so I'll sneak up and grab that little bird!" (CAT)
