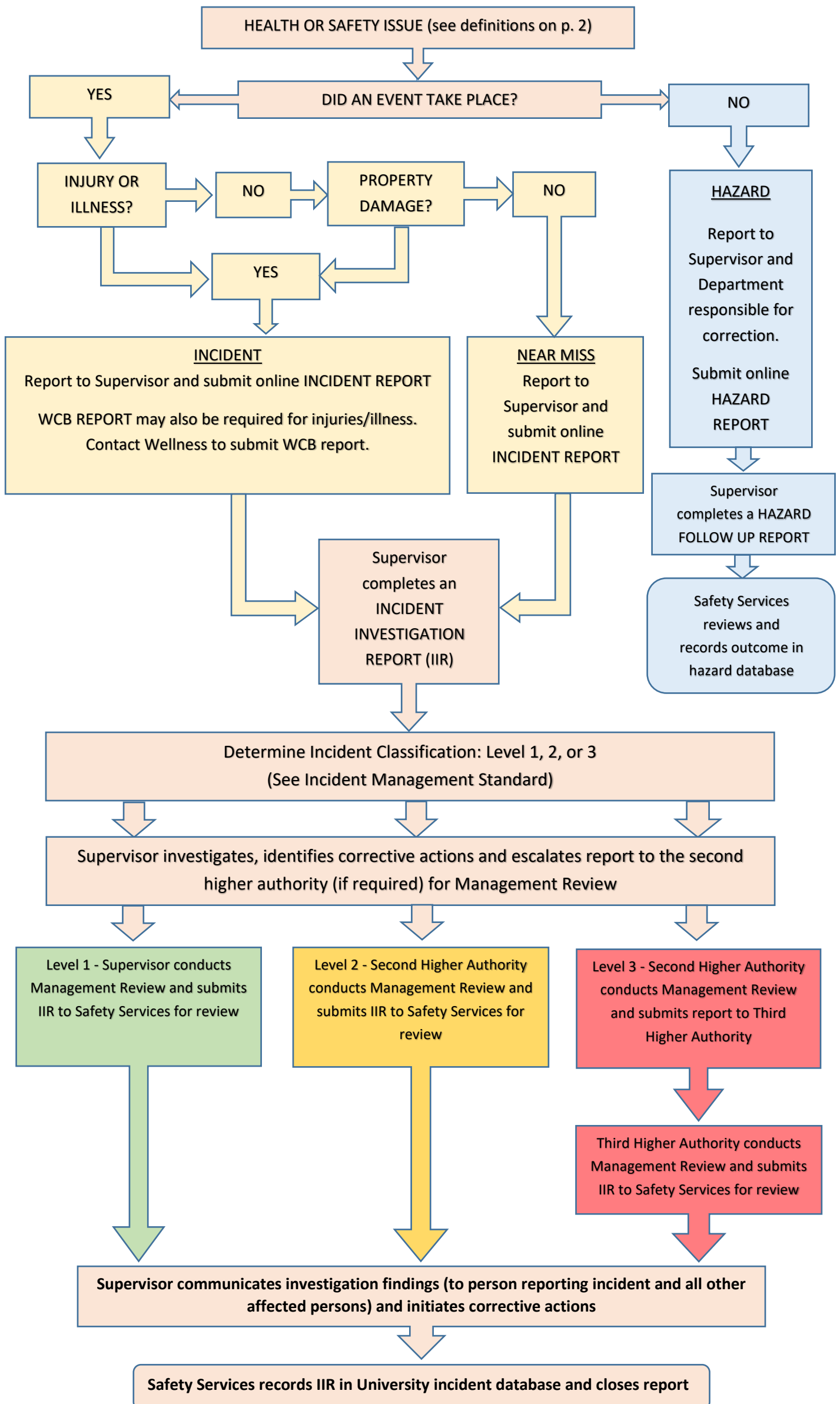

Definitions:

Incident: an unplanned event resulting in, injury, ill health or damage or an incident resulting in a dangerous event (e.g. a fall causing injury)

Near Miss: are incidents that cause no injury or damage but that could have caused serious injuries or property damage under slightly different circumstances (e.g. slipping on a water puddle without falling or sustaining an injury).

Hazard: an object or situation with the potential to cause harm to a person or property (e.g. an open pit without barricades to prevent someone from falling in). When hazards are observed, they can be regarded as a lapse or deviation from standard working practices.
