



GENERAL HEALTH & SAFETY GUIDELINES FOR MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC

The University has an ethical as well as a legal responsibility to provide a safe environment for all members of the University community. The University strives to foster a shared responsibility for health and safety whereby the risk of injury to persons or the damage to property or facilities is minimized.

Members of the public may have various reasons for attending campus and must be aware of the following:

Access:

- Campus access is restricted at this time; however, some service operations have reopened such as the University Health Centre, Rebound Health Centre, Sport and Recreation Services, etc. Follow any directions given for accessing campus, parking, health screening, wearing a mask and/or other safety information given as part of your appointment.
- [Face masks are required](#) in all public and common areas.
- Practice safe habits and follow all campus policies, posted signage, regulations, and instruction by campus personnel.
- Members of the Media should coordinate the purpose and logistics of their visit with the [University of Lethbridge Communications Office](#).

Emergencies:

- In the event of life-threatening emergencies, **call 9-1-1** and then **Security Services at 403.329.2345**.
- Members of the public who are given direction by a University employee as to safety, regulations, or access issues shall follow the directions given.

Reporting:

- Members of the public that are involved in or have observed an accident, injury, hazard, unsafe condition, or safety concern on University property shall immediately report to Campus Safety at **(403) 329-2345**.
