

## POST EXPOSURE PROCEDURE

Exposure protocol applies to puncture wounds due to contaminated needles or sharp instrument, a splash of blood/body fluids, hazardous chemicals or biological agents into the eyes, mouth or non-intact skin, bites and/or scratches

- 1. Get immediate First Aid
- 2. For needle stick injuries or sharps:
  - Encourage bleeding of injury.
  - Cleanse the site by washing with soap and water.
  - Cover injury with sterile dressing or bandage.
  - Consult PSDS/MSDS if required.
- 3. For eye/mouth/nose splash:
  - Flush with water for 15 minutes.
  - Consult PSDS/MSDS if required.
- Contact Supervisor and report incident.
- 5. Seek medical attention immediately for evaluation care. Information which will be useful to the health care professional:
  - Copy of the PSDS/SDS
  - the description of employee's job duties,
  - route of exposure
  - circumstances of exposure
  - vaccination status
