	Supervisor submits <u>Recommendation of the Award of the Degree-Edcuation</u> form to the Graduate Program Office ( <u>edu.masters@uleth.ca</u> ).  Student is contacted by Graduate Program Office with <u>instructions to submit Project via OPUS</u> . The Project will be reviewed/approved by the Associate Dean of Graduate Studies and Research in Education and the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies.  NOTE: When planning for deadlines, students should budget sufficient time for submission of Project in e-project system and final approvals. See <u>School of Graduate Studies Policies and Procedures</u> , in particular <u>Table 15</u> : <u>Application for graduation deadlines</u> . <b>Registration in the next academic term is required for any graduate student who has not received decanal approval of the Project by the end of the academic term.</b>
