University of Lethbridge Spring 2022 Convocation week activities

This week, the University of Lethbridge will celebrate the achievements of three graduating classes with an unprecedented six, in-person convocation ceremonies over three days. A total of 1,220 students will cross the stage at Spring 2022 Convocation, including 934 from the class of 2022 and another 286 students from the 2020 and 2021 graduating classes. Past graduands have accepted the invitation to return to campus to

walk the stage having missed the experience due to COVID-19 limitations that necessitated online ceremonies.

This week's ceremonies take place Wednesday, June 1 (past graduands), Thursday, June 2, and Friday, June 3, at the 1st Choice Savings Centre for Sport and Wellness., beginning at 9:30 a.m. and 2:30 p.m. each day.
