SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

- Allow faster groups to play through when possible
- Do not alter the course (trees, bushes, etc) in any way
- Pick up trash and put in proper receptacles
- If you find a lost disc, please return it to Customer Service Centre (in Centre for Sport & Wellness)
- No smoking, vaping or consumption of alcohol on the course
