Inclusive Education Specialization

What is the Inclusive Education Specialization?

While all Education students are expected to have the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively manage and teach students with diverse learning needs, students completing a specialization will have an enhanced ability in the area.

What courses are required?

- Education 4582: PS III, Inclusive Education Internship
 - Spring semester only, offered at the kindergarten to grade 6 level
- Education 43XX: Educational Foundation course
- Three of:
 - Education 4702: Individualizing Instruction in the Regular Classroom
 - Education 4703: Assessment for Individualized Educational Programming
 - Education 4263: Language Arts Instruction for Students with Learning Difficulties
 - o Education 4709: Issues in Special Education (Series)
 - Education 4520: Specialized Practicum (Series) (in a special/inclusive education setting)

Note: Completion of the course work above is a prerequisite to registration in Education 4582 – Inclusive Education Internship (PS III). Course substitutions must be approved by Student Program Services.

What paperwork is required?

- 1. Declare the Inclusive Education Specialization by completing a *Student Program Change* form.
- 2. Submit an *Application for <u>PSIII Specialization and Internship Options</u> form to SPS by the due date of the Fall or Spring PS III Information form.*
