### **Inclusive Education Specialization**

#### **What is the Inclusive Education Specialization?**

While all Education students are expected to have the knowledge and skills necessary to effectively manage and teach students with diverse learning needs, students completing a specialization will have an enhanced ability in the area.

#### **What courses are required?**

- **Education 4582:** PS III, Inclusive Education Internship
  - Spring semester only, offered at the kindergarten to grade 6 level
- **Education 43XX:** Educational Foundation course
- **Three of:**
  - **Education 4702:** Individualizing Instruction in the Regular Classroom
  - **Education 4703:** Assessment for Individualized Educational Programming
  - **Education 4263:** Language Arts Instruction for Students with Learning Difficulties
  - **Education 4709:** Issues in Special Education (Series)
  - **Education 4520:** Specialized Practicum (Series) (in a special/inclusive education setting)

**Note:** Completion of the course work above is a prerequisite to registration in Education 4582 – Inclusive Education Internship (PS III). Course substitutions must be approved by Student Program Services.

#### **What paperwork is required?**

1. Declare the Inclusive Education Specialization by completing a *Student Program Change* form.
2. Submit an *Application for [PSIII Specialization and Internship Options](#)* form to SPS by the **due date** of the **Fall or Spring PS III Information form**.
