



Food Service Options for events held in the University of Lethbridge, Sport & Recreation Facilities.

In compliance with the University of Lethbridge's Provision of Food & Alcohol Services Policy, the following guidelines must be followed when providing food during events held on campus:

Formally Catered Events, greater than 50 people.

For formally catered events that require food or beverage services located within the Sport & Recreation Facilities, one of the approved food caterers must be used. This requirement applies to any food provided for the public and for large groups over 50 people.

Informally Catered Events, less than 50 people.

For informal private groups, such as officials/volunteers for sporting events, birthday parties, and small celebrations, food may be provided within our facilities if the following conditions are met:

1. Discuss the details about food at events held within our facilities with Sport & Recreation Services staff before the event.
2. Serve the food in a non-public area where only the rental group participants are allowed, the general public is not permitted, and no fee is charged to participants.
3. Ensure the size of the group is less than 50 people.
4. Do not provide alcoholic beverages unless arranged through a formal catering agreement with one of the approved caterers listed above.
5. Preferably provide non-perishable and pre-packaged food items, including non-perishable snacks and baked goods.
6. If any prepared and precooked commercially prepared foods are served, ensure they are adequately stored until served.
7. Do not serve any potentially hazardous foods, including meats, salads with a mayonnaise base, dairy products, or egg products.
8. Do not serve any potentially hazardous hot foods (home-prepared), such as lasagna, chicken, casseroles, or crock pots.
9. All guests participate at their own risk.
10. The user group holds harmless and indemnifies the University from all claims, actions, judgments, including all costs of defense and attorney's fees incurred in defending against same, arising from the provision of food or beverage at such events.
