Career Bridge is committed to assisting you in your recruitment. We will work within your hiring procedures to streamline your access to students from our campuses in Lethbridge and Calgary, as well as our graduates.

Individual sessions and booths will be arranged through Career Bridge. For the Fall 2023, sessions can be booked either in person or virtually, but we will only accommodate one session per day, to ensure students can attend all of the events they are interested in. We recommend evening sessions to avoid class conflicts. Sessions and booths may be booked online on a first come, first served basis.

Please note: When scheduling activities on the Lethbridge campus keep in mind that students are encouraged NOT to miss classes, Their class schedules begin at 8am with classes running for 1 hour,15 minutes with 10 minutes between classes. We can also facilitate information sessions on the Calgary campus; the recommended time to hold a session would be 4:00 - 5:45pm.

Five Simple Steps to Hiring a University of Lethbridge Student

You can post your co-op, summer and new grad postings conveniently in one location.

1. Visit Our Job Board

- Postings are accessible through our online job board to both Lethbridge and Calgary campus students, as well as alumni. To post, visit myexperience.uleth.ca. If you haven't already, begin by creating your profile. If you run into any difficulties, please contact us at career.bridge@uleth.ca
- If you already have a profile, please login and begin posting.

2. Post Your Positions

- You will be able to post directly from your dashboard, which will provide you the option to post a job to either "Co-op Job Postings" or to "Career Job Postings".
- Fill in the information on the job posting form for each area. Please note: Fields with an asterisk (*) are required.
- Once you have submitted the job posting form, your posting will be in "Pending" status to be approved for student view.
- If you have identified "Online" as the mode of application, students will be directed to your website to apply.

3. Compile a List of Students for Interviews

- Notify Career Bridge of your short list by emailing career.bridge@uleth.ca.
- Applicants selected for interviews will be contacted and interviews arranged according to the dates and times you have specified.

4. Conduct Interviews

- Telephone, video conference and in-person interviews can be arranged by Career Bridge at no cost to you.
- Interview rooms are available on both the Calgary and Lethbridge campuses or interviews can take place at your place of business.

5. Select the Student Who is the Best Fit and Notify Us

- Career Bridge does not have a ranking and matching system so employers know the status of their offer to a student without significant delay.
- Career Bridge will notify remaining applicants of selection decisions at your request.

Postings can be submitted at any time, and if you run into any difficulties, simply email us at career.bridge@uleth.ca to assist you.

CPA BRIDGING

CPA Bridging enables students to complete the business and accounting courses needed for entrance into the CPA Professional Education Program (PEP), or to upskill in their current careers. The bridging program was designed specifically to enable those with a four-year degree in any discipline to enhance their business and finance acumen, and/or transition into a career as a CPA. Students in CPA Bridging at the U of L have the opportunity to participate in paid co-op work terms, student professional development, case competitions & business simulations.

CPA Bridging serves four groups of aspiring finance and accounting professionals:

- New Canadians with international accounting credentials or an international degree in any field
- Working professionals considering a change of careers
- University graduates in fields other than business
- University graduates with business degrees without an accounting background

CPA Bridging students at the University of Lethbridge bring a diverse range and breadth of experience, knowledge, and skills to their future accounting career.

CPA Bridging is currently offered through the University of Lethbridge at the Calgary and Lethbridge campuses, with classes being offered during weekends and evenings in Calgary to accommodate the working student.

OUR COMMITMENT

We will do our best to assist you in your recruitment of University of Lethbridge students and graduates.

Career Bridge manages the Fall accounting recruitment process for U of L students and graduates, along side the Dhillon School of Business. Each year we email all accounting majors to inform them of the process. We provide assistance to all current University of Lethbridge students across all disciplines, as well as alumni. Over 8000 current students in two campus locations across the province (Lethbridge and Calgary) are eligible to access our services.

On average, we have 250 active alumni accessing our graduate employment services each year.

Co-operative Education

This work experience program is facilitated through the Career Bridge office in Lethbridge and Calgary.

The program features high caliber students who are required to meet GPA requirements and participate in career development workshops that prepare them to achieve in the workforce. Co-op is full-time employment and can be 4, 8 or 12 months in length. Hiring a co-op student is a sound recruiting strategy as it provides employers with an opportunity to assess the fit and skill set of potential future leaders within their organization.

Career Bridge and the Dhillon School of Business work collaboratively and agree that learning is enhanced and maximized with the application of classroom knowledge in a real world setting. We are grateful to those of you who support and understand the benefits of co-op to both students as well as to your recruitment processes.

It is our expectation that all students enrolled in co-op programs who apply to positions posted through the program adhere to the agreed upon policies and complete the work terms accordingly.

Alberta Accounting Recruitment Timeline – Fall 2023

To Whom It May Concern,

For the fifth year in a row Alberta Post-Secondary Institutions are jointly adhering to a structured fall 2023 recruitment timeline for all accounting students which includes Co-op placements, internships, or permanent positions that begin at any point in 2024. The objectives behind this structured approach to recruitment are intended to benefit the recruiting companies, academic institutions, and the student candidates. Participating Alberta Academic Institutes include:

University of Lethbridge Career Bridge & Dhillon School of Business

The structure was created with input from the University of British Columbia, the aforementioned

Alberta post-secondary institutions, the CPA Alberta, and a subset of public firms. We are working with our students to ensure this new timeline is well understood and adhered to.

Permanent Accounting Recruitment Timelines Fall

RenguistrenstDatestober 20th, 2023.

Any firm meeting a student during this period can present an Offer of Employment but offers must remain open until October 20th, 2023, allowing the student to attend interviews, events and be informed of their options before accepting. Any offers presented from now until August 21st, 2023, and or after October 20th, 2023, will be open market. Employers will fill positions as their business needs dictate.

Co-op Accounting Recruitment Timelines for Winter & Summer 2024 Job

Board Goes Live: August 21st, 2023

Interview Start Date: September 30th, 2023 Offer Acceptance Deadline: October 20th, 2023

NOTE: From October 20th, 2022, onward, offers can be made at any time, and students must respond in accordance with their school's co-op guidelines.

A key element with this structure is that offers can be made once interviews have begun. However, candidates are not required to respond to any offers until October 20. This allows firms time to interview and make offers without the pressure of having to rush their offers, and it allows the candidates time to attend interviews and not be required to respond to offers immediately. That said, if the candidate is satisfied with an offer, they have the option of responding before October 20th.
