

I. The Residence Dining Plan is Mandatory

The Residence Dining Plan is MANDATORY for all students staying in University Hall, Kainai House and Piikani House Residences. No exceptions.

IMPORTANT: Students must select and remit a deposit on a Residence Dining Plan option prior to arrival and check-in at Housing to enable move-in to Residence. Payment is full is due by October 1, 2023

Your Dining Plan is active from the start of each term unless otherwise stipulated in your License Agreement with Housing, and will remain active until the expiry date of your License Agreement.

Residence Dining Plan Options:

Option 1: Commuter Plan (Mandatory Minimum Plan):

* Total Value: \$4,300 Base Dollars: \$3,600 Flex Dollars: \$ 700

Our value option designed for students who do not plan to remain on campus most weekends and holidays. The Commuter Plan is suited to those students with more modest appetites.

Budgeted minimum consumption per week, excluding scheduled breaks:

- Base Dollar consumption is estimated at \$136.36/week
- Total Value (Base and Flex Dollars) is estimated at \$162.88/week

Individual consumption rates may vary.

Option 2: Standard Plan (Optional Upgrade):

* Total Value: \$4,990 Base Dollars: \$ 3,600 Flex Dollars: \$1,390

Best suited for students who plan to spend more time on campus including some weekends and holidays. The Standard Plan is also recommended for those students with larger appetites.

Budgeted minimum consumption per week, excluding scheduled breaks:

- Base Dollar consumption is estimated at \$136.36/week
- Total Value (Base and Flex Dollars) is estimated at \$189.02/week

Individual consumption rates may vary.

Residence Dining Plan Options:

Plan Size	Total Cost	Plan Description	
Commuter	\$4,300	Our most popular plan, designed for students who are off campus most weekends and those with average appetites. This plan has both base and flex dollars. Base Dollars: \$3,600 Flex Dollars: \$700	
Standard	\$4,990	Appropriate for students on campus alternate weekends and those with larger appetites. This plan has both base and flex dollars. Base Dollars: \$3,600 Flex Dollars: \$1,390	
Sampler	\$2,100	Available for those students NOT on the mandatory Dining Plan. Provides convenience and value for daytime dining, vending purchases and After Hours. This plan is flex dollars only. Flex Dollars: \$2,100	

Guidelines

- > These are only general guidelines and do not necessarily apply to every student.
- > All plans are due and payable by October 1.
- > Base Dollars can be used at retail food outlets.
- > Flex Dollars can be used at retail food outlets, vending machines, and for After Hours Dining.
- > Resident students on a mandatory Dining Plan may select either the Commuter or Standard Plan.

Your Dining Plan Has Two Key Components

Base Dollars

Base Dollars allow you to purchase food, exempt from GST, from any CHARTWELLS operated dining outlet on campus.

Base Dollar purchases are tax free. (Alberta only has a 5% GST tax, No PST or HST).

Limitations:

AFTER HOURS residence delivery program and Snack & Beverage vending machine purchases are not permitted with your tax free Base Dollars, due to Canada Revenue Agency regulations.

Flex Dollars

Flex Dollars allows you to purchase food from any CHARTWELLS operated dining outlet on campus, buy food via our *AFTER HOURS* residence delivery program, and you can use your Flex Dollars for purchases at most Snack & Beverage vending machines on campus. All purchases are taxable (GST).

** Funds can be added to the Flex Dollars at any time. **

Food Plan Innovation Fund

All mandatory dining plan students are required to pay a one-time \$80.00 Innovation Fund fee. This fee is leveraged exclusively for new products & services requested by the Organization of Residence Students (ORS) Dining Plan Committee based on feedback from the residence population. All unused residual Innovation Funds will be carried forward each year. No Innovation Fund will be declared revenues by either the Food Service provider, or University Food Services.

II. RESIDENCE DINING PLANS MUST BE PAID IN FULL ON OR BEFORE OCTOBER 1st.

METHOD OF PAYMENT

PAYMENT OPTIONS: Debit or Online Payments

Online Payments

Proceed to your Bank's website; create the University of Lethbridge as new payee. When asked what your account number is, quote your nine digit U of L ID number. When choosing this option, allow a day or two ahead of the deadline date for payment to reach the University

III. Balances and Carry-Forward

Your Dining Plan covers **BOTH** the Fall and Spring semesters.

Account balances from the Fall semester (September – December) will be transferred to the Spring semester (January – April) if you remain a resident in University Housing.

Base Dollars

Funds remaining on your Base Dollars at the end of the Spring Term will be TRANSFERRED IN FULL to Flex Dollars after May 1. There will be no penalty or fee for this transfer.

No Risk Flex Dollars

Funds remaining on your Flex Dollars will remain active and available for your use throughout your time at the University and will not expire.

Dining Plans are not refundable or redeemable for cash. If there are Flex Dollars remaining when you complete your time at the University, a refund will be issued.

IV. Withdrawal from Residence Dining Plans

A processing fee of \$75 will be charged for early withdrawals for reasons other than academic withdrawal. GST will be assessed on all Base Dollar purchases and deducted from the balance remaining for remittance to the Canadian Revenue Agency. Refund calculations for withdrawal from the dining plan will be based on the weekly Base Dollar consumption schedule and residence eligibility.

V. Your University ID Card is your Residence Dining Plan Card

Without your card, you'll have to pay cash.

You Are Responsible For Your ID Card

You will be responsible for any purchases on your card up to the time you report your card lost or stolen. It is your responsibility to replace lost or stolen cards.

VI. Special Dietary Requirements

If you have food allergies or specific dietary requirements (medical, cultural, religious, lifestyle, personal preference, other), be sure to contact Food Services prior to signing the Optional Dining Plan contract with any questions relating to your individual dietary needs.

While we will strive to address your dietary requests, please be advised the University of Lethbridge Food Services may not be able to accommodate all individual dietary needs or preferences.

No refund or reduction in the mandatory dining plan will be considered due to dietary restrictions.
