

Ajou University is a leading research university in South Korea established in 1973, located in the greater Seoul area. We have 13,700 domestic students and 1,400 international students from 67 countries. The university consists of 12 colleges with leading programs in fields such as artificial intelligence, future automobiles, molecular science and technology, energy systems, a medical center, and a law school

Classes (6 credits) - choose two tracks

Track 1 Sustainability

[SUS] The course assists students in developing a general understanding of globalization's effects on climate. Students will gain a general knowledge of policies associated with decarbonization as intended measures to contain climate change impacts.

Track 2

Managing People in Organizations

[MPO] The course is to help students be better prepared to work with, motivate, and lead othersin the organizations.

Basic concepts in Organizational Behavior and related fields will be introduced and discussed.

Track 3

Macroeconomic Development

[MD] The course will cover topics such as macroeconomics, growth accounting, labor markets, consumption and saving, international trade, and macroeconomic policies.

Track 4

Korean Language

[KOR] Let's learn Korean together! The topics covered include greetings, asking for directions, shopping, ordering Korean food, and others.


