## ROLOFF BENY FOUNDATION GRADUATE AWARD IN PHOTOGRAPHIC ARTS

The Roloff Beny Foundation Graduate Award in Photographic Arts is intended to recognize academic and artistic achievement of an M.F.A. student who demonstrates a commitment to or focused interest in photographic practice. This award was established by the Roloff Beny Foundation to provide travel opportunities to complement the creative activity of outstanding students. The funds must be used to offset costs incurred by travel, photography (equipment and/or supplies), and/or tuition or fees. ### **Eligibility:**

- o At the time of application, applicants must be currently enrolled in any M.F.A. program at the
- University of Lethbridge.
- Applicants must demonstrate an understanding of the social, theoretical, material and/or aesthetic issues of photography, including related technologies or practices, within the context of contemporary art.
- The award is tenable upon confirmation of full-time enrollment at the University of Lethbridge during the semester in which the application is made.

#### Criteria:

- The successful candidate will demonstrate academic achievement (minimum GPA of 3.0) and excellence in photographic arts.
- Recipients are selected by a committee comprised of members of the Department of Art, Faculty of Fine Arts.
- This is a competitive award and proposals are adjudicated on the merit of submissions.
- Within six (6) months of completing the project, successful candidates must submit a single PDF to <u>art@uleth.ca</u>. This PDF should include a 500-word written report and visual documentation of the work created with the support of the award. An exhibition showcasing the work can be held in the Department of Art.

Applications must include the following items submitted as a single PDF document no larger than 20 MB:

- Application Form.
- Personal Essay: maximum 500 words.
- Portfolio of Work: 20 images that cohesively represent your work with an accompanying image list.
- o Proposed Budget.
- Proposed Project Dates.
- Curriculum Vitae (CV).

	Applications must include the following items submitted as a single PDF document.  [Merge all documents into a single PDF document, organized in the order below.]
1.	Application Form A completed Application Form is included as the first page of your PDF document.
2.	Personal Essay: maximum 500 words  A Personal Essay should address your research/creative interests as they relate to photography, including related forms (themes or issues explored in your work; theoretical, social, aesthetic and/or formal concerns, as relevant), and a proposal to travel. The relationship between your proposed travel (places and dates included) and your research interests should be clearly described. If you intend to use the award to defray costs related to the purchase of photographic equipment and/or supplies, and/or tuition or fees for further study, these costs must also be outlined and rationalized within the essay. The essay must be a maximum of500 words, titled with the award name, your name and date.
3.	Portfolio of Work  A Portfolio of Work consists of a maximum of 20 images that cohesively represent your work, and an accompanying image list. Your image list should include for each image the title, date, medium, dimensions. Brief descriptions of work may be included for context.
4.	Proposed Budget  A Proposed Budget must balance projected Expenses and Revenues, to a maximum award value of \$5,000.00. Expenses may be incurred for travel (economy airfare, train, bus, mileage or fuel, accommodation, and meals [per diem \$45/day]), tuition and/or fees for further study, photographic costs (equipment, accessories, software, supplies, etc.). Expenses and Revenues should be formatted in columns and totalled.

6.	Curriculum Vitae (CV)  A CV outlines your professional accomplishments to date. It should list your education, scholarships and awards, exhibitions (group, solo, course related), publications, community service / involvement, employment experience, special skills (languages, travel, technical, other).
