Lethbridge-based Ward Bros. Construction selected to renovate Southern Alberta Medical Program teaching facility

Ward Bros. Construction has been selected to renovate the Centre for Community Wellbeing (CCW), on the University of Lethbridge campus, which will house the new Southern Alberta Medical Program (SAMP). An innovative partnership between the University of Calgary's Cumming School of Medicine (CSM) and ULethbridge, SAMP offers students the opportunity to earn a UCalgary medical degree while completing their training in southern Alberta.
