

CO-ED VOLLEYBALL RULES

ELIGIBILITY

- 1. Each participant must have **one (1)** of the following:
 - a. Valid Student ID card.
 - b. Proof of payment of appropriate team player fee.
 - c. All participants must be registered on the official roster, must check in with the supervisor for each game and have picture ID at all times. Additions are permitted up to the second last week of the regular season (wk 5). No additions are allowed from week 6 to the end of Playoffs.
- 2. All participants on the official team roster must play at least **two (2)** regular season games to be eligible to play in play offs.
- 3. Six (6) players per team are permitted on the court at the same time.
- 4. Co-Ed Rule teams may have a maximum of five (5) same gender (m/f/n) on the floor at the same time.

Inclusivity

At the University of Lethbridge, we value equity, inclusion and diversity. University of Lethbridge acknowledges the commitment to representing the diverse communities we serve. And while we have gender-based leagues, they are inclusive of the LGBTQ2S+ community, transgender and genderqueer persons. We encourage participants to play where they feel comfortable.

GAME

- 1. Each match will consist of the best of three (3) games, or a maximum of fifty-five (55) minutes. Each game will be played up to twenty-five (25) points with a cap at twenty-seven (27). The rally point scoring system will be used.
- 2. A **Ten (10)** minute default rule will be enforced. Therefore, each game must start by ten minutes past the hour. A team must have 4 players or it will default the game.

STANDINGS

1. League standings will be determined by the results in Fusion Play.

RULES: Standard CVA rules will apply, except:

- 1. Jump-spike serves are not permitted (penalty: loss of possession).
- 2. Back-row spikes are not permitted (penalty: loss of possession).
- 3. One 30-second timeout permitted each game (i.e. Three 30-second timeouts per match).
- 4. Substitution may occur only in the position after the service position.
- 5. No blocking of an attempted serve (penalty: point awarded to serving team).

FIGHTING, UNSPORTING CONDUCT OR DELIBERATE INTENT TO INJURE WILL NOT BE TOLERATED AND WILL RESULT IN AN AUTOMATIC DISOUALIFICATION AND EXPULSION FROM ALL LEAGUES.
