Proper Dress Code According to Blackfoot Ways

In respect to the Spiritual Blackfoot Elder/Grandfather (Aa' wah ' staaksa – Kaahsinnoon)

Woman must wear proper clothing; no miniskirts, short dresses, shorts or low-cut blouses or tops. A woman's legs must be covered.

This is part of the respect for the Blackfoot woman. Women can wear long pants. Men also must not wear shorts, t-shirts, and/or sleeveless shirts.

For women, please use the blankets, shawls, and scarfs available prior to participating or being near the smudge.
