Applications must be received by the **Scholarships and Student Finance Office by June 30.** The Scholarships and Student Finance Office is not responsible for any applications lost in the postal system. **Late or incomplete applications will not be considered.** Successful applicants will be notified by letter in late October.

- * Awards are tenable only at the University of Lethbridge and only for the specified year.
- * According to Canadian tax regulations, students must have a Social Insurance Number in order to receive an award. This award, if granted, is not considered taxable income but the appropriate T4A will be issued for funds disbursed in each calendar year as required by Canada Revenue Agency. If you do not currently have a SIN number, this can be left blank, however it must be supplied to the University before this award can be disbursed.
