

## Safe Work Procedures - Patching

General/Brief Description of task	Patching of holes in wall to prepare for painting
Frequency of task performed	Daily
Hazards Identified	#4 – Dust / Vapours
P.P.E. required: Special tools required (if any)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Dust Mask</li><li>• Pole &amp; Hand Sanders</li><li>• Trowels</li><li>• Filler Pans/Hawk</li></ul>
Safe Work Procedure	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Visually inspect area for possible hazards</li><li>• Refer to product labels for any necessary precautions to take</li><li>• Add water to Filler to obtain desired thickness</li><li>• Scoop mud onto hawk</li><li>• Using trowel, fill holes with Patching Filler and smooth to blend with wall</li><li>• Let patching dry prior to painting</li><li>• Sand with 120 grit sandpaper</li><li>• Apply finish to wall</li></ul> <p><b>For larger holes</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Cut piece out and fit with drywall</li><li>• Tape and apply Filler to blend with wall</li><li>• Apply one coat of primer and 2 coats of finish allowing adequate time between coats for product to dry</li></ul>
