<p>General/Brief Description of task</p>	<p>Cutting of wood, metal, or plastic for various construction projects as per work order or blueprint patterns.</p>
<p>Frequency of task performed</p>	<p>Daily as per work orders.</p>
<p>Hazards Identified</p>	<p>#4 Dust/Vapours</p>
<p>P.P.E. required: Special tools required (if any)</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Varying with tools used Band Saw • Safety Glasses Circular Saw • Table Saw • Jig Saw
<p>Safe Work Procedure</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Visually inspect worksite for any possible hazards • Ensure all guards are in place and no loose clothing near equipment or power tools • All personal protective equipment corresponding to the tool used must be worn • Refer to Safe Work Practice for "Use of Power Tools" as found in Appendix 'A' • Refer to Safe Work Practice for "Use of Non-Powered Hand Tools" as found in Appendix 'A' • Refer to Safe Work Practice for "Electrical Safety" as found in Appendix 'A' • Refer to Safe Work Practice for "Use of Electrical Extension Cords" as found in Appendix 'A' • Refer to Safe Work Practice corresponding to specific carpenter shop equipment • Cut pieces according to work order or blueprint patterns • If piece is too large to hold and cut, obtain assistance • Refer to Safe Work Practice for "Proper Lifting Techniques" as found in Appendix 'A'
