Eligibility: Undergraduate students enrolled in a B.Sc. Program.
Performing original research and registered in one of the following courses: Biol 3990, Biol 4990, or Biol 4995.
Supervised or co-supervised by a member of the Department of Biological Sciences.
Participation in the Undergraduate Research Symposium.

Criteria: Best symposium presentation.

Tenable: Tenable upon successful completion/participation in the Undergraduate Research Symposium.

Application: Not required.

Recipient Selection: Decisions on recipients will be made by designated competition judges to be determined on a year to year basis
