All other documents pertaining to English Language Proficiency (e.g., TOEFL) must be received no later than the preceding August 1 for fall admission, or November 15 for spring admission.

All other documents pertaining to English Language Proficiency (e.g., TOEFL) must be received no later than the preceding August 1 for fall admission, or November 15 for spring admission.
