About the Post-Diploma The Post-Diploma Bachelor of Fine Arts (Multidisciplinary) program enables **B.F.A.** (Multidisciplinary) students to change direction and move into a new or different fine arts focus, which may be particularly useful in meeting entrance requirements for Program graduate school. It also affords an excellent preparation for students wishing to pursue professions in fine arts fields such as art therapy, art administration, performance, journalism, musical theatre, recreation, education, applied theatre arts and technology, arts criticism, or design. **Maximum Flexibility** The program provides the flexibility to pursue studies in the Departments of Art, Theatre and Dramatic Arts, and Music in combination with courses from inside or outside the Faculty of Fine Arts. The 10 electives, from either the Faculty of Fine Arts or any other faculty on campus, can support the student's chosen career path. **Contact an Academic** Students accepted into this program must contact an Academic Advisor in the Advisor Faculty of Fine Arts (tel. 403-329-2158) for guidance and information about available options and the particular path to pursue. Students admitted to the Post-Diploma Bachelor of Fine Arts **Program Requirements** (Multidisciplinary) (After a Two- or Three-Year Diploma) are required to complete a minimum of 20 courses, including 12 courses in the discipline (Art, Drama, or Music) at the University of Lethbridge. A grade point average of at least 2.00 must be maintained at all times. **Course Requirements** All current specified course requirements for the B.F.A. (Multidisciplinary) will apply. Courses from the diploma program may apply. Depending on the content of the diploma presented, students will be required to complete a 20-

course subset of the courses required for the four-year degree program.
