About the New Media Minor

A minor in New Media is available as an adjunct to all majors in the Bachelor of Management degree, Post-Diploma Bachelor of Management degree, Professional Diploma in Accounting, Management Certificate, B.Mgt/B.Ed., Post-Diploma B.Mgt/B.Ed., and second degrees in Management. In some cases, achievement of the minor and a chosen major will require a student to take extra courses. For students who complete all the requirements, the minor in New Media will be acknowledged on the official transcript (see Part 11 - Faculty of Management in the 2012/2013 Calendar).

Why Complete a New Media Minor? The objective of this minor is to give Management students a survey of the new media field and introduce them to design fundamentals and principles of new media. Students will also be able to choose courses that add to their knowledge of visual communications, video production, media/advertising, and/or other topical issues.

Minimum Grade Requirement

A minimum grade of 'C-' is required in all courses taken towards the New Media Minor.
