Notes

Time Limits - All degree requirements must be completed within seven years of the first Nursing course used for credit towards the degree.

Minimum Grade Requirements - A minimum grade of C is required in Nursing 1163/Nursing 1220 and Nursing 1173/Nursing 1320. A student who receives a grade of C- or less must repeat the course prior to proceeding in the program. A minimum grade of C- is required in all other Nursing courses.
